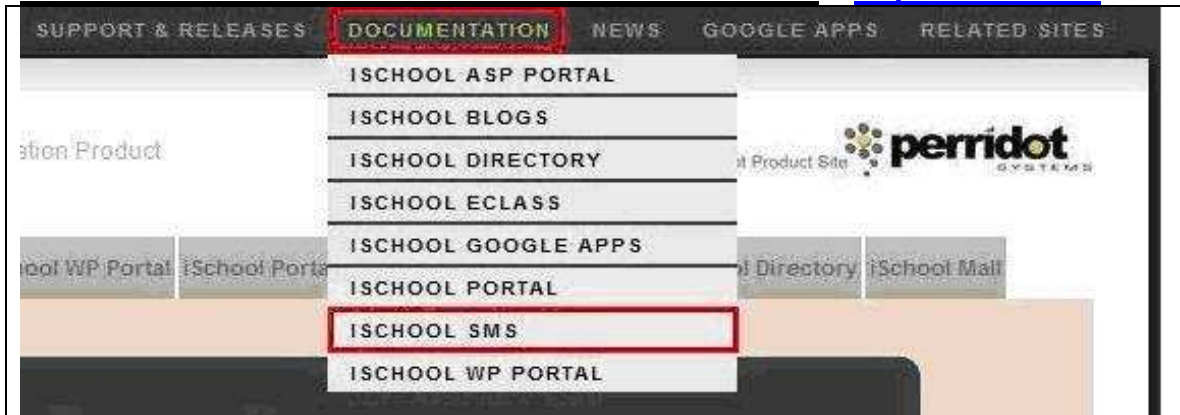

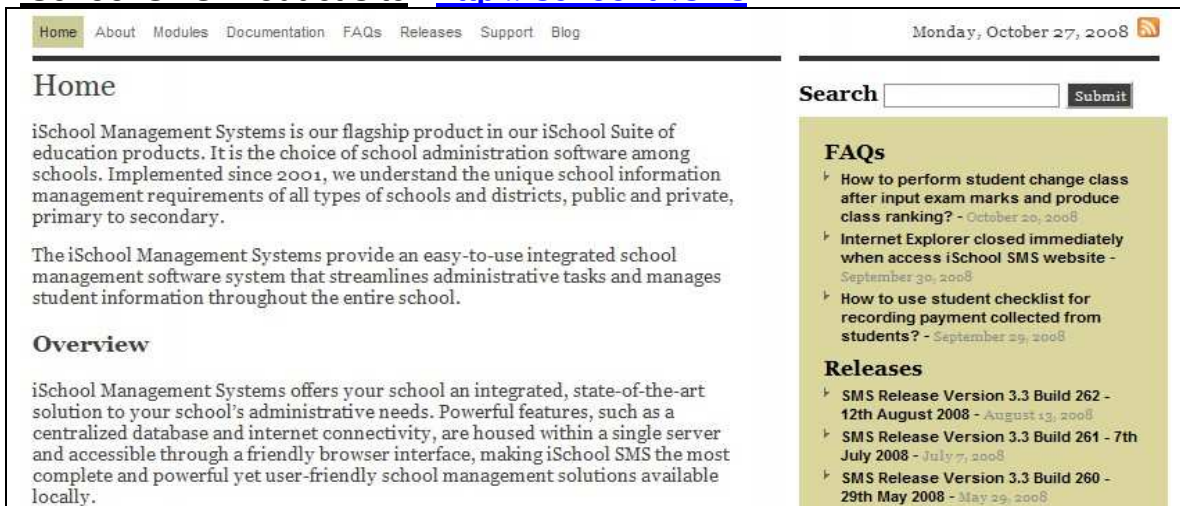
3 – Merging of iSchool SMS
